SCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES

Education aims at moulding children into responsible, productive and useful members of the society. Knowledge skills and attitudes are built through learning experiences and opportunities created for learners in schools. It is in the classroom that learners can analyse and evaluate their experiences, learn to solve doubts, to question, to investigate and think independently. Students of Class X have the option to choose standard/Basic Maths according to their calibre.

The innovation of CBSE, Assessment in Speaking and Listening (ASL) is conducted for classes X and XII. Slow Learners and Dyslexic students are given more attention and guidance by our Special Educators. Maths camps are arranged for students to enhance their mathematical skills. Night camps are part of the remedial teaching for students appearing for the Board Examinations.

The Academic year is divided into two terms - Term 1 (June to September) and Term 2 (October to March).



CO- SCHOLSTIC ACTIVITIES

Various activities targeted for the all round development of the personality of the child takes place in the school. They include debates, public speaking, quiz competitions, recitations, extempore, drawing, painting, athletics, seminars, projects and tours. Training for co curricular activities takes place on Wednesdays. Children choose their option of interest. Experts train the students in all fields like shuttle badminton, karate, baking, handy crafts, music, key board, taekwondo, chess, hockey tinkering, creative writing, drawing and painting, IT, mime and drama. Sports Meet, Annual Day and Literary Competitions are conducted every year. Inter and Intra school competitions are conducted to foster the spirit of participation, leadership and a healthy competition. Cultural programmes and activities to develop creative writing are also emphasized. A variety of clubs – the Literary Club, the Science Club, the Eco Club, the Mathematics Club, the IT Club, the Social Club, the Language Clubs, the Writers Club, the Health and Wellness Club and the Social club actively function through out the year. These clubs enhance the team spirit and creative skills of the students. Innovative workshops and camps on novel ideas like visual media, documentaries and discussion on current events, Journalism, departmental activities and days of global importance are added activities in the co-scholastic field. Students are inspired and motivated to participate in all these activities to mould them into versatile geniuses. Karate classes are held for boys and girls.

EVALUATION & PROMOTION

Evaluation of Plus One is School - based and of Plus Two is the All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISSCE) Conducted by the CBSE. It is mandatory for students of Class XII to score pass marks in each individual Elective Subject and Practicals.

For Elementary classes, skill based evaluation is conducted monthly and terminal exams are conducted at the end of each term. For classes VI to X Scholastic Areas are assessed through Internal Assessment and Terminal Examinations. Internal Assessment includes Periodic Tests, Multiple Assessments, Portfolio and Subject Enrichment. Students are also evaluated in Co- Scholastic Areas like Work Education, Art ducation, Health & Physical Education, Discipline etc.

ADMISSION DETAILS

Application for admission should be submitted in the prescribed forms, which will be available at the school office during working hours. Students who have completed MONTE 2 in this school may directly seek admission to class I. They may be re admitted in the same procedure with the requisite fee before 15th January every year positively. The copies of the Birth Certificate, Aadhaar Card of the child, School Leaving Certificates of the parents and recent passport size photographs (4 nos) of the child are to be attached with the application form. However the original certificates are to be presented for verification at the time of admission.

Students seeking admission to class 2 and above are instructed to submit the TC also at the time of admission. Application forms are to be filled in completely and submitted on time. Late submission of application forms will be rejected. Both father and mother are to accompany the student at the time of admission. The Principal reserves the right to accept or reject any application. The new academic session starts on June 1st.

Documents to be submitted with the application form:

1. A Passport size photo to be attached to the application form along with one more photo.
2. A self-attested copy of the Birth Certificate.
3. The mark list of the previous school for students seeking admission from class 2 onwards.
4. School Leaving Certificate of the parents.
5. The proof regarding completion of Kindergarten course attested by the Headmistress / Principal of the previous school for students seeking admission to class 1.

Documents to be submitted at the time of admission :-

1. The Original Birth Certificate of the child, School Leaving Certificate of the parents (will be returned after verification).
2. A recognized T.C issued by the previous school.
3. The Conduct Certificate from the Principal of the previous school for students seeking admission from class 6 onwards.
4. Original mark list of the previous school for verification.

The following criteria are considered while admitting a child:-

1. Proficiency in the subjects concerned.
2. General conduct and behaviour/discipline.
3. Preference for brother/sister of a student already in the school.
4. Submission of valid documents.



AN EFFICIENT & COMFORTABLE FRAMEWORK

Payment of the School Fees:

There are two modes for payment of Tuition Fees:

1. Payment of complete fees on or before June 30th.
2. Payment in three instalments in June, August and October. All the other fees can be paid as per the entry in the school logbook. Payment can be made by online. While making online payment, the name of the student, class and the name of the parent to be specified.

FEES ONCE PAID WILL NOT BE REFUNDED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

Withdrawals:

Notice regarding the withdrawal of a student has to be submitted to the Principal one month in advance. All the school dues including the fees must be paid and the school properties returned before the T.C is issued. The Principal has the right to demand the withdrawal of a student from the school without assigning/disclosing any reason and fees paid in respect of such students are not refundable.

Leave Rules:

All applications for leave are to be signed by the parents. Applications for medical leave should be supported by a Medical Certificate. Leave will not be granted during examination period. A student's name will be removed from the rolls if he/she is absent for 10 working days continuously unless the leave is sanctioned by the Principal in advance.

Such students can be re-admitted only after paying a re-admission fee of Rs. 1000/-, with other dues if any. Re-admission of such students will be at the discretion of the Principal.

IT Education:

To set up new standards in the Educational sector and excel in the cyber area, a high quality of effective training is necessary in the field of computers. This aims at empowering the children in the world of technology. Specially designed software are implemented to enhance the ability of each child thus making the learning process interesting and enjoyable. IT education is imparted for classes 1-12.

Smart Class rooms:

A revolutionary change in the field of education will improve the academic performance of the students. Smart Class Rooms is one such step towards it. It is a digital learning for better perception of lessons. The smart class is designed to empower teachers with technology right inside the classrooms making learning more interesting, informative and impressive. This enables the students to acquire better understanding of the concepts taught in the class. They enjoy the process of learning enabling them to improve their academic performances. It also helps to teach the abstract curriculum and concepts which the students find difficult to comprehend. This facility is available for all classes.



Guidance and Counselling:

The School arranges regular counselling and guidance sessions for students. General awareness and personality development classes are arranged by expert resource persons at regular intervals for both students and parents. These sessions have proved to be truly fruitful.

Labs:

Well equipped and sophisticated labs for Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Mathematics and Computers are maintained for conducting practicals in a full fledged and systematic manner.



Library:

The School maintains a well stocked library with over 6000 books in Malayalam and English which are classified and catalogued. The library subscribes to 25 periodicals. 3 copies of English Newspapers and a copy of Malayalam Newspaper are distributed to classes 3 - 12 every day. A serene reading room is also maintained for hassle - free reading.

Special Education:

School provides regular special education sessions for supporting students with special needs to face their academic challenges. Activity oriented teaching VAKT (Visual, Auditory, Kinesthetic, Tactile) approach of teaching, attention and concentration increasing games such as racket bouncing, craft works, mental ability increasing puzzles are some of the remedial training activities given. Parental counselling, teacher guidance etc are also provided to manage these students at home and classroom respectively.

1. Lab facilities open for student community from in and around Al Haramain English School (Open Lab concept).

system is designed to train students to read, write and speak English, understand the concept of Numbers, develop everyday practical life skills and Holistic approach of moulding the students to become a better citizen of tomorrow. The main skills developed are Sensorial, Arithmetic, Language, Cultural, EPL and Moral Ethics. Parenting forms a part of the curriculum and parents are given guidance for upbringing of the child.

A UNIFORM OF ORDER

Uniform

Uniform attire promotes equality and discipline. The school logo is compulsory for the Uniform and belts. Uniform is compulsory for all the students.

Boys:

- Classes 1 and 2 : Blue 3/4 th shorts, beige with one sided blue and green strip half sleeve shirt. Black shoes and navy blue socks.
- Classes 3 to 10 : Blue pants, beige with one sided blue and green strip half sleeve shirt. Black shoes and navy blue socks.
- Classes 11 and 12 : Dark grey pants, beige and blue stripes with one sided blue and green strip half sleeve shirt. Black shoes and black socks.

*** NOTE : LOW WAIST PANTS AND SHORT SHIRTS ARE NOT PERMISSIBLE.**

All boys are to wear black belts with school logo.

Girls:

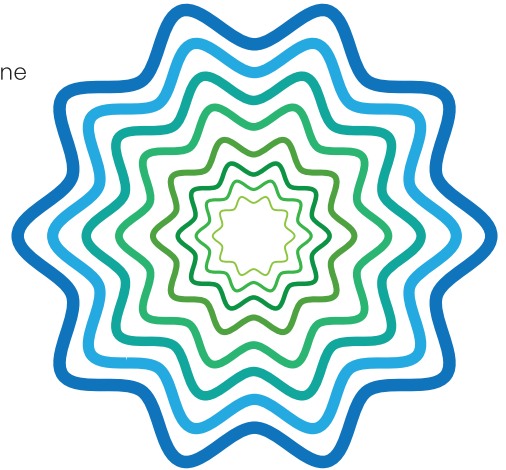
- Classes 1 and 2 : Blue pinafore, beige with one sided blue and green strip half sleeve shirt. Black shoes and navy blue socks.
- Classes 3 to 10 : Beige with one sided blue and green strip full sleeve kameez, blue straight pants and blue scarf (only for muslim girls). Black shoes and navy blue socks.
- Classes 11 and 12 : Dark Grey pants and dark grey sleeveless coat, beige and blue stripes with one sided blue and green strip full sleeve kameez and dark grey scarf(only for muslim girls). Black shoes and black socks.

School Days and Hours:

The school is open 6 days a week – Monday to Saturday for Classes 6 to 12 and 5 days a week Monday to Friday for Classes 1 to 5. School hours for students are from 8.30 am to 3.10 pm. Students are to be in school before 8.25 am and expected to leave promptly at 3.10 pm.

School Holidays:

The school calendar issued every year to pupils states all holidays including some of the school programmes and activities. Generally the school remains closed on all Sundays and other public holidays. The school informs parents about alteration in these days, if any via log book or mobile messenger.





CODE OF CONDUCT

Every institution frames and maintains a set of rules for the effective maintenance of discipline.

To implement this we monitor and take care that:

1. Students are punctual.
 2. Students dress neatly in proper school uniform.
 3. Students bring only the necessary books and stationary items to school and avoid other harmful periodicals or magazines.
 4. Students do not wear or carry valuable articles like gold ornaments, CD's, videos, games, mobile phones or any electronic items; (if found a fine of Rupees 1000/- will be imposed)
 5. Students do not leave the campus without the permission of the Principal /Vice Principal.
 6. Students maintain good conduct and respect all members of the staff and peers.
 7. Students speak English
 8. If a student falls ill or if unable to attend classes during any working day, an application for the leave is submitted to the class teacher duly signed by his / her Parent or guardian.
- The detailed rules and regulations of the school are available in the student's Log Book. All parents and students are to abide by them.
