General Statistics

We have 1586 students across 60 divisions [44 Divisions in school and 16 divisions in Ripples)], 98 (72 + 26) teachers and 40 non-teaching staff in our rolls. We have accommodated 17 new teachers in this academic year against retirements and resignation.

Academic Wing

We have ten Departments (English, Malayalam, Hindi, Arabic, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Physical Education, Information Technology, Islamics) led by experienced teachers and eminent staff for Special Education, Conselling and Art.

Board Exam & Majlis Public Exam results

AHES students brought glittering results in the last AISSE and AISSCE for our school. 4 full A1 in Class X Exams and 15 full A1 in Class XII exams. The no. of distinctions increased this time to 36 in Class X and 70 in Class XII.

AISSE 2024:

- 4 students secured full A1 grades.
- 36 students achieved distinction.
- Top Scorers: Muhammed Haneen (98%), Fathima Thamanna (97%) and Heba P.S. (96.8%).

AISSCE

- 14 Full A1 in Science, 1 Full A1 in Commerce.
- Science Stream Top Scorers: Jafna Jamal (96.6%), Nouba Sherin (96.2%), Fathima Nilofar (96%).
- Commerce Stream Top Scorers: Lamiya Mammotty (95%), Noura V (87.8%), Aysha Riyas (83.6%).

In the Majlis Primary & Secondary Examinations too, AHES students won stupendous success.

80 students attended the Secondary Certificate Examination out of which 22 students secured A+ and 18 students secured A grade. 125 students attended Primary Certificate Examination out of which 20 students secured A+ and 23 secured A grade.

Hizza Raees ranked among the top ten winners in Primary Certificate Examination and Haya AT in Secondary Certificate Examination.

To celebrate this glorious achievement, we organized the Felictation Ceremony on June 22, 2024 with Mr.Nisam.A.P. (Former General Secretary of CIGI). The toppers and other winners were awarded with trophies.

- Misbah Harish of Class X has got entry tin the India Book of Records for writing the name of a country in maximum number of languages.
- Our school team has been selected as the Best Girls Team in the Kozhikode District Inter School Team Chess Championship 2024-25. Hizza Raees, Aysha Kenza Muneer and Fathima Hana were the team members.
- Rezin Ahammed secured third prize in Inter school Chess Tournament conducted by Vidya Council for Education.
- Hayash Adam Shan of Class I bagged Gold medal in the district level skating championship. He has also secured Bronze medal in State level championship. Muhammed Mahir T P of Class IV secured Gold medal in 1000m, Silver medal in 500m and Bronze medal in 200m.
- Amilia PV has secured third prize in 600mtr in the athletic meet conducted by Vidya Council for Education. She also secured Silver medal in District Wushu Championship.
- Our students were the semi finalist of 'Hack 4 Future' a National level tech hackathon.

- This year at CBSE District Kalotsav our School secured a total of 355 points and bagged 9th position in overall.

- Our school were the first runner up in Kids Fest 2024 conducted by IECI.
